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Please briefly present the organisation / the group.

Smokinya Foundation contributes in creating a world that works for everyone out of love, care and cooperation.

The organization serves as a learning platform for youth ready to commit to their own learning and development. We create opportunities and provide space for people to learn, contribute and grow by participation, volunteering and leadership.

Our approach is heuristic – a method for empowering a person to discover or learn something for themselves. Smokinya provides an alternative context of learning – experiential, ‘hands-on’ or learning by doing.

Smokinya Foundation realizes its vision and values through youth work. We provide regular open activities in which youth joins driven by personal interest. We train, coach, mentor, educate, and support youth in developing competences and make choices for their life, education, and career.

It started in 2013 as online blog for popularising youth mobility, which grew to an informal group in 2014. In 2016 Smokinya Foundation was registered in public benefit. We come from different backgrounds: business, marketing and humanities non-formal education, volunteering and extracurricular youth activities. Our experiences make a rich mixture of competences, skills and values.

Smokinya aims at:

- support for young people in their growth through non-formal educational
- encouragement of lasting interest in life-long learning, educational mobility, volunteering
- raising the quality of youth projects and the capacity of youth NGOs by sharing cross-fertilized methods of training, coaching, coordination and management
- promotion and facilitation of cross-sector networking for innovation, enrichment, inclusion, cooperation, exchange of transferable skills, attitudes and competences

How do we do all that?

- by partnerships and participation in international projects and initiatives
- volunteering in different causes involving those in need (fewer opportunities young people and NEETs)
- participating in trainings and bringing fresh new ideas and content in our work

- networking and cooperating with NGOs, businesses and experts from variety of fields: youth, consulting, training and education, coaching
- organizing seminars, workshops, trainings focused on competences and trends in personal and organizational development

Our target group

Young and adult people 16-35 with fewer opportunities, who are facing a transition in their life based on economical, geographical, social, cultural or educational circumstances. Specifically, young adults who are looking for first job, career, change of field, new educational qualification, relocating or experiencing certain limitations. Those feeling “lost”, inactive, not working, not studying, somehow confused or outdated in the contemporary dynamic and challenging world.

Our methods: experiential learning, NLP, mentorship and coaching, outdoor and adventure learning, creativity and spontaneity, systemic work and constellations, art (theater, dance, performance). More here: <https://smokinya.com/about/method/>

We have partnered in over 120 projects in the past 7 years and we have sent more than 700 participants in projects worldwide. We keep expanding our work and deliver quality opportunities for youth, youth workers, volunteers, educators and people involved in support of other people.

Smokinya Foundation follows the UN youth agenda 2030, the 11 Youth goals, and EU strategy in the field of youth to Engage, Connect, Empower.

What are the activities and experience of the partner organisation in youth work? Please provide information on your organisation's / group's regular youth work activities at local level.

Smokinya Foundation acknowledges non-formal education as valuable in developing youth's competences and attitudes. We are experts in non-formal and experiential learning, supporting young people to discover their own talents. In this project our youth workers would have the chance to strengthen their skills and create a wider network for cooperation.

In our work we use: non-formal education and experiential learning, different forms of arts, creativity, outdoors, coaching and mentoring.

We find those rich sources of learning as we Reach out to local and international youth, we Engage with them, offering opportunities to Connect, and learn, in order to become Empowered in line with their needs and EU youth strategies for 2030, focusing on environment and the 17 UN SDGs.

As a part of this application, we are going to promote, and send participants to the activities in order to spread our experience and expertise and get new approaches from the other partners of this project. We have sent over 700 people to youth exchanges, training courses and different volunteering and open call project in the past 7 years. We

have experience in promoting, raising, selecting participants, evaluation, follow-up and dissemination.

Locally we regularly organise events which gather 40-60 young people who participated in different projects, and those who never participated in Erasmus+. We Reach, Engage, Connect, Empower thru facilitation of peer to peer networking and sharing.

An active member of several EU youth networks. Tihomir is volunteering since 2004 and is trained in experiential learning methods, certified for coaching and mentoring, and utilizing methods from NLP, systemic work, body movement. Tihomir signs the partnership agreements and mandates, supervises and keeps a track of project timelines (promotion, selection, preparation, sending, follow-up, evaluation, dissemination, closing, reporting). Holds a professional certification for psychological counselling of youth.

Anna Sipos is a trainer with a master degree in Adult Education Management. She was an intern in the Flemish Ministry of Education gaining experience in program tailoring and curriculum development. She is working as a youth trainer for more than 10 years, using mainly the method of creative recycling in different areas: personal development, social entrepreneurship, sustainability, arts and design. Anna is a youth worker in Smokinya Foundation.

Maria Stefanova – Board member of the foundation and an international and community development worker. She has over 18 years of living and working abroad, in different locations worldwide for NGOs based in UK. With background in Business and Humanities, she is an integral part of Smokinya Foundation with her rich expertise. As a Board member Maria is supporting the operations of the organisation with consultancy, and partnership building.

Alexandra Leonova is a youth worker at Smokinya Foundation who takes care of youth activities, events, facilitation. She has 5 years of experience and comes from cultural background that allows her to have a wide view on challenges, observe diversity and encourage self-expression. By education Alexandra is a sociologist.

Merlin Redzhebova is a youth worker who takes care of the daily operations, partnership building and working with local staff and volunteers. She an administrator with a professional stance and ability to focus and bring results. In her work she uses art and games in order to empower youth to exercise their imagination and self-reflect gamification.

Petia Chalakova is an international trainer with 8 years of experience in non-formal education. Her specialties are critical and analytical thinking, environmentalism, social advertisement, civic society and social entrepreneurship. She has degree in Philosophy and Sociology, Marketing and Advertisement, Semiotic and Linguistic. Petya has PhD in New Media Art Critique and is trainer and project designer in Smokinya Foundation. EVS volunteers support our field work with contribution to administrative, coordination and promotion activities. In 2018-21 we are ongoingly hosting 5 long-term ESC volunteers.

Smokinya Foundation maintains a community of youth workers, youth trainers, and volunteers who join on a project based manner. Our active youth leaders self-organised themselves based on common interest and vision and formed informal groups through which they communicate, coordinate, organise and deliver different non-formal learning programs.

Dissemination

Smokinya Foundation has active online presence. We have mailing lists with more than 3000 subscribers (participants, volunteers, partner NGOs, inquirers, supporter and donors), directly and indirectly reaching to at least 5000 youth.

Using all these channels which provide high-reach, visibility and transparency of follow-up and dissemination of results. Those platforms make it easy to track and evaluate specific numbers and stats.

Our participants get fresh new ideas and inspiration, learn new methods and tools and will plan follow-up and dissemination while still in the activity. After coming back home Smokinya staff will meet them, discuss, encourage to take action and provide support so follow-up and dissemination happen soon after the project activity.

We will target young people 16-35 years old, unemployed, studying, working or in transition between educational degrees or career paths, those who need support and motivational experiences to freshen them up.

Why and how will participants sent by Smokinya benefit from this project?

We have a community of over 60 regular attendees of our local events in Plovdiv, Sofia, Stara Zagora, Varna and Blagoevgrad. We also host EVS volunteers who promote educational mobility and Erasmus+. Becoming partner in this project will continue a good practice we have and have developed by sending over 700 young people to projects in more than 35 countries. That provides the needed experience to create understanding in the first-timers in Erasmus+ what it means mobility, non-formal education and experiential learning. Then when we close every project with follow-up and dissemination those living examples serve as inspiration for other youth to join. That is also the lifecycle of how Smokinya Foundation raises volunteers, interns, project coordinators.

How does the proposed project match with your needs, interest and mission? What do you expect as outcomes of this project?

Smokinya Foundation works with diverse tools for reaching out to and engaging youth. We use mainly variety of non-formal educational and experiential learning approaches. **In this new partnership and project we want to gain** new competences, methods, and contacts which will enrich us for our local work.

Smokinya Foundation expects to create a new set of tools and bring in expertise in planning and project design and writing, as a methods in our routine activities – networking for youth, cultural events for youth, educational events related to healthy behaviours, mobility within and outside of EU etc.

What do you expect to be the direct impact and benefit of this project on you and your target group?

We expect to enrich our toolbox and that way to be more interesting, more engaging and preferred youth NGO locally in Plovdiv, Bulgaria. With this project we believe we can achieve that.

Please describe at least one concrete dissemination or follow-up activity you might implement as a result of our project and how many people would be involved?

Knowledge sharing workshop where our participants from the project will share their experience and learning with peers 17 to 30 years old. We also will create a promo video of the workshop and further share this topic and how is it useful in youth work. We expect that we can directly reach out to and bring to the workshop a group of 60-100 young people – high school graduates, university students, unemployed youth.

Why do we want to be part of this project? How does the project fit the needs of our organisations.

Smokinya Foundation works annually with hundreds of local and international youth. We have field experience, observation and evidence that youth is facing a multitude of challenges in the contemporary world, not only now during the global pandemic, but in the past decades trends are intensifying.

Namely, trends of low critical thinking, low social skills, low soft skills, increased stress due to mass media and social media, and worsening climate change, and much more. Our organisation needs new, proactive, attractive, and innovative ways that provide solutions to contemporary problems. Art, theater and other artistic methods of expression are proven to bring mindfulness, awareness, leadership and self-development skills, together with physical activities, artistic tools, gamification, environment, sustainable and responsible behaviour, and mindful usage of digital tools can be solutions.

We want to join this project in order to strengthen our collaboration and partnership, and to bring new innovative methods in order to equip our youth workers and youth with competences and perspectives in alignment with contemporary trends.

How have you identified these needs?

We work in a network of 50 NGOs all across the EU and outside the EU. We have regular meetings and we share common vision, values and ideas about youth work, support of young people with fewer opportunities and disabilities. Our partners have agreed and we have carried out empirical observation and research on what are the trends in youth problematic topics, behaviours, mental and physical health. We have evidence based observations and trends in youth problematics, and we are actively testing new ways, innovative methods in order to tackle the problems and provide quality support to our

local target groups, as well as in general to the mainstream problems of youth beyond national borders.

Moreover, we follow statistical data and research on legit internationally recognized platforms and portals like Eurostat, World Health Organisation, university academic researches.

How being part of this project could benefit our organisation? How could it benefit your local area?

Smokinya Foundation works annually with hundreds of local and international youth. We need to stay active and informed of new attractive methods, as well as to provide activities of non-formal education. That way we keep our community alive and strengthen our local and international partnerships and impact. Our participants will gain experience and learn skills, develop competences, our local target group will benefit from the implementation stages and dissemination by participating, observing and being involved with us and our international partners. At the same time the local authorities and local governmental youth department will have the opportunity through our experience to enrich their own understanding of the benefits of Erasmus program and its Key actions.
